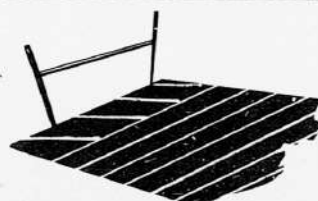
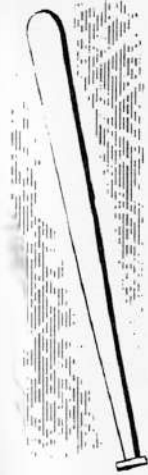


EIGHTH GRADE CLASS

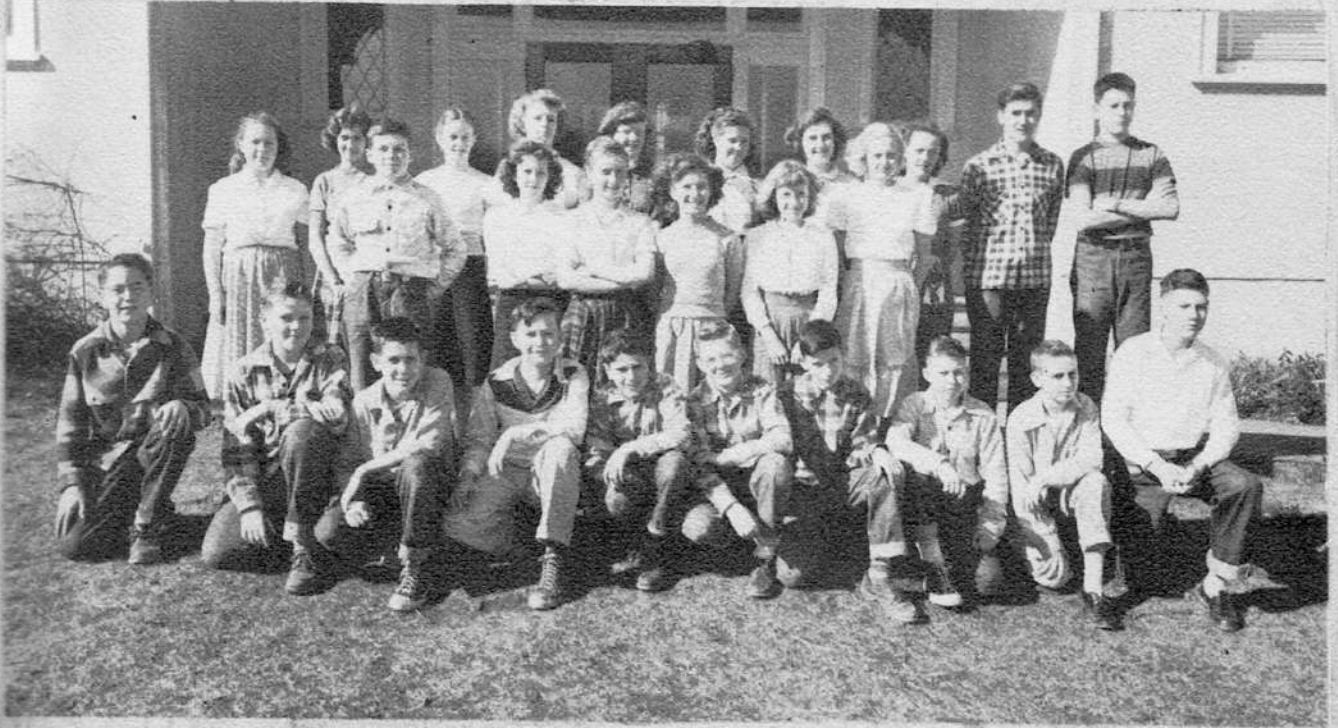

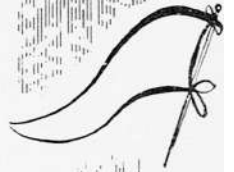




ANNUAL STAFF
