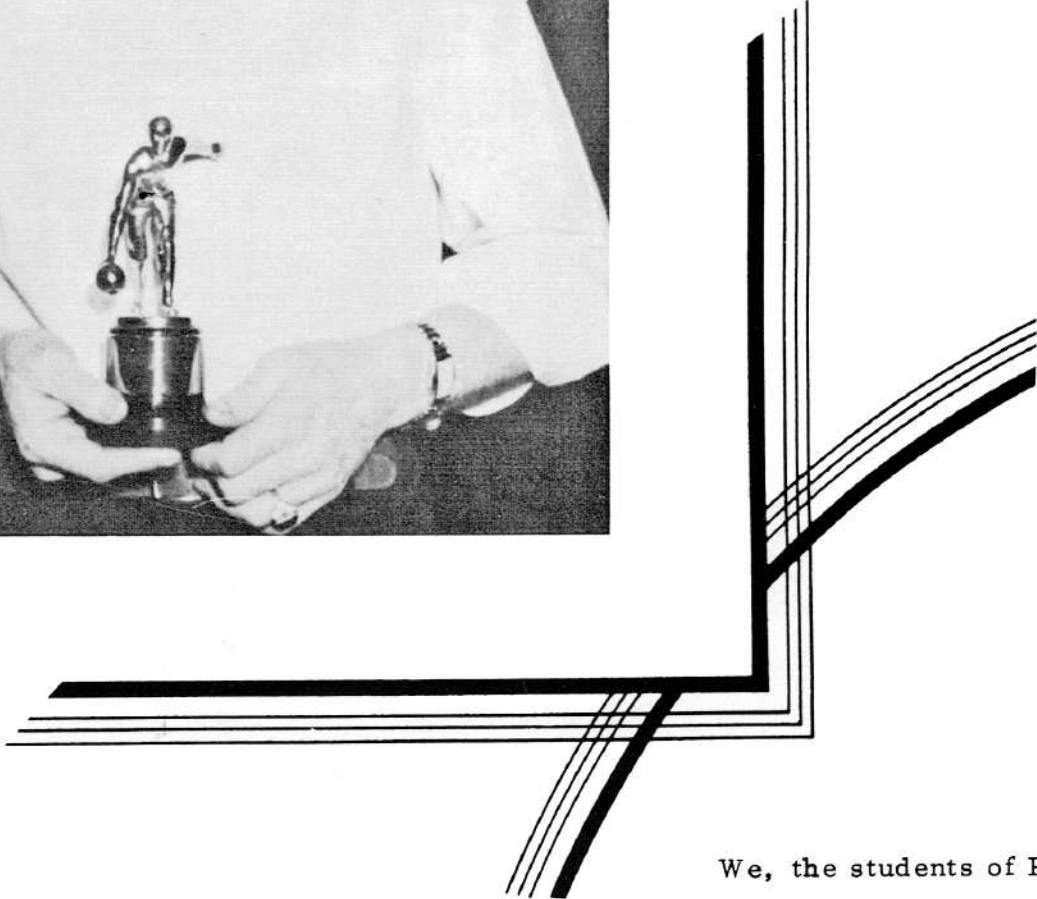
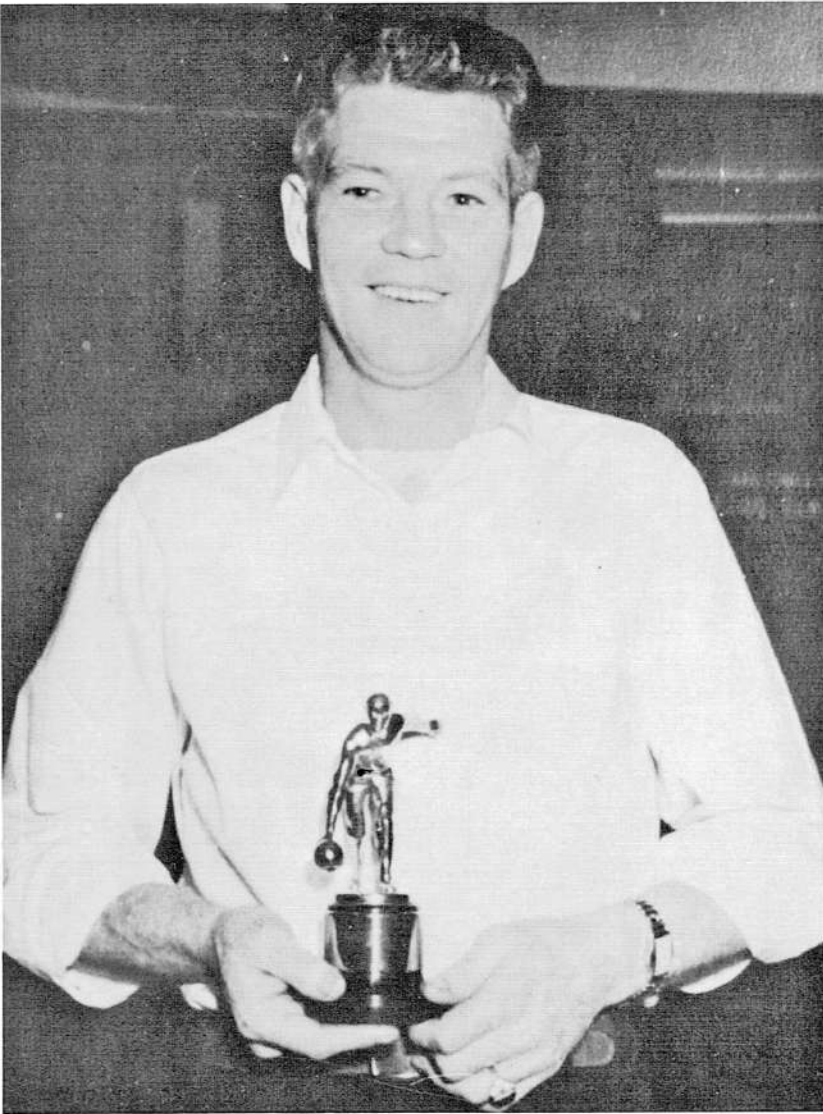


Foreword
